January 8

FCQ. 125 – *Why did Christ appoint these sacraments?* To mark us off from the world, and to give us comfort and strength.

SCQ. 104 - What do we pray for in the fourth petition? In the fourth petition, which is, Give us this day our daily bread, we pray that of God's free gift we may receive a competent portion of the good things of this life, and enjoy his blessing with them.

January 15

FCQ. 126 - What sign is used in baptism? Washing with water.

FCQ. 127 – What does this washing with water represent? Union with Christ by cleansing through his blood.

SCQ. 105 – *What do we pray for in the fifth petition?* In the fifth petition, which is, And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors, we pray that God, for Christ's sake, would freely pardon all our sins; which we are the rather encouraged to ask, because by his grace we are enabled from the heart to forgive others.

January 22

FCQ. 128 - In whose name are you baptized? In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

FCQ. 129 - Who are to be baptized? Believers and their children.

FCQ. 130 – *Why are we baptized even as little infants?* Because God's command to Abraham is obeyed in our baptism.

FCQ. 131 – *What did Jesus say about little children?* "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these."

SCQ. 106 - What do we pray for in the sixth petition? In the sixth petition, which is, do not lead us into temptation, But deliver us from the evil one, we pray that God would either keep us from being tempted to sin, or support and deliver us when we are tempted.

<u>January 29</u>

FCQ. 132 – What does your baptism call you to be? A true follower of Christ.

SCQ. 107 – What does the conclusion of the Lord's Prayer teach us? The conclusion of the Lord's Prayer, which is, For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen, teaches us to take our encouragement in prayer from God only, and in our prayers to praise him, ascribing kingdom, power, and glory to him; and, in testimony of our desire, and assurance to be heard, we say, Amen.

February 5

FCQ. 133 – What sign is used in the Lord's Supper? Eating bread and drinking wine in remembrance of the suffering and death of Jesus.

FCQ. 134 - What does the bread represent? Christ's body sacrificed for our sins.

FCQ. 135 – What does the wine represent? Christ's blood shed for our sins.

SCQ. 1 – What is the chief end of man? Man's chief end is to glorify God, and to enjoy him forever.

SCQ. 2 – What rule has God given to direct us how we may glorify and enjoy him? The Word of God, which is contained in the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments, is the only rule to direct us how we may glorify and enjoy him.

February 12

FCQ. 136 – *Who may rightly partake of the Lord's Supper*? Those who repent of their sins, believe in Christ and live a new life.

SCQ. 3 – *What do the Scriptures principally teach?* The Scriptures principally teach, what man is to believe concerning God, and what duty God requires of man.

February 19

FCQ. 137 – Did Christ remain in the tomb after he was buried? No – he came back out of his tomb on the third day.

FCQ. 138 - Where is Jesus now? At the right hand of the Father, praying for us.

FCQ. 139 - Will the Lord Jesus come again? Yes! He will return to judge the world on the last day.

SCQ. 4 – What is God? God is a Spirit, infinite, eternal, and unchangeable, in his being, wisdom, power, holiness, justice, goodness, and truth.

February 26

FCQ. 140 - What will happen to us when we die? Our bodies will return to dust, while our spirits return to God.

FCQ. 141 - Will the bodies of all the dead be raised again? Yes – some will be raised to everlasting life and others to everlasting death.

SCQ. 5 – Are there more Gods than one? There is but one only, the living and true God.

March 5

FCQ. 142 – *What will God do to the unbelievers on the last day?* He will cast them into the lake of fire, along with Satan and his angels.

FCQ. 143 – What will the lake of fire be like? It will be an awful place, where the lost will suffer for their sins forever.

SCQ. 6 – How many persons are there in the Godhead? *There are three persons in the Godhead: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost; and these three are one God, the same in substance, equal in power and glory.*

March 12

FCQ. 144 – *What will God do for believers on the last day?* He will give them a home in the new heaven and the new earth.

FCQ. 145 – *What will the new heaven and the new earth be like?* It will be a glorious and happy place, where the saved will be with Jesus forever.

SCQ. 7 – What are the decrees of God? *The decrees of God are, his eternal purpose, according to the counsel of his will, whereby, for his own glory, he has foreordained whatsoever comes to pass.*

<u>March 19</u>

FCQ. 1 – Who made you? God.

FCQ. 2 – What else did God make? God made all things.

SCQ. 8 – How does God execute his decrees? God executes his decrees in the works of creation and providence.

SCQ. 9 – What is the work of creation? The work of creation is, God's making all things of nothing, by the word of his power, in the space of six days, and all very good.
