Memory Work

2 Timothy 3:16-17 – All Scripture *is* given by inspiration of God, and *is* profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, ¹⁷ that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work.

Hebrews 11:3 – By faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that the things which are seen were not made of things which are visible.

Genesis 1:27 – So God created man in His *own* image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.

1 John 2:3-4 – Now by this we know that we know Him, if we keep His commandments. ⁴ He who says, “I know Him,” and does not keep His commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him.

Psalms 1 – Blessed *is* the man who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor stands in the path of sinners, nor sits in the seat of the scornful; ² but his delight *is* in the law of the Lord, and in His law he meditates day and night. ³ He shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that brings forth its fruit in its season, whose leaf also shall not wither; and whatever he does shall prosper. ⁴ The ungodly *are* not so, but *are* like the chaff which the wind drives away. ⁵ Therefore the ungodly shall not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous. ⁶ For the Lord knows the way of the righteous, but the way of the ungodly shall perish.

Exodus 15:11 – Who *is* like You, O Lord, among the gods? Who *is* like You, glorious in holiness, fearful in praises, doing wonders?

Exodus 15:13 – You in Your mercy have led forth the people whom You have redeemed; You have guided *them* in Your strength to Your holy habitation.

Exodus 20:20 – And Moses said to the people, “Do not fear; for God has come to test you, and that His fear may be before you, so that you may not sin.”

Leviticus 20:7-8 – Consecrate yourselves therefore, and be holy, for I *am* the Lord your God. ⁸ And you shall keep My statutes, and perform them: I *am* the Lord who sanctifies you.

Numbers 6:24-25 – The Lord bless you and keep you; ²⁵ the Lord make His face shine upon you, and be gracious to you; ²⁶ the Lord lift up His countenance upon you, and give you peace.

Deuteronomy 10:12-13 – And now, Israel, what does the Lord your God require of you, but to fear the Lord your God, to walk in all His ways and to love Him, to serve the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul, ¹³ and to keep the commandments of the Lord and His statutes which I command you today for your good?

Joshua 1:9 – Have I not commanded you? Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor be dismayed, for the Lord your God *is* with you wherever you go.

Joshua 21:45 – Not a word failed of any good thing which the Lord had spoken to the house of Israel. All came to pass.

Judges 5:31a – Thus let all Your enemies perish, O Lord! But *let* those who love Him *be* like the

sun when it comes out in full strength.

Hebrews 12:28-29 – Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom which cannot be shaken, let us have grace, by which we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear. ²⁹ For our God *is* a consuming fire.

Ruth 1:16 – But Ruth said: “Entreat me not to leave you, *or to* turn back from following after you; for wherever you go, I will go; and wherever you lodge, I will lodge; your people *shall be* my people, and your God, my God.

1 Samuel 12:24 – Only fear the Lord, and serve Him in truth with all your heart; for consider what great things He has done for you.

1 Samuel 16:7b – For *the Lord* does not *see* as man sees; for man looks at the outward appearance, but the Lord looks at the heart.

2 Samuel 7:28 – And now, O Lord God, You are God, and Your words are true, and You have promised this goodness to Your servant.

Psalms 51:17 – The sacrifices of God *are* a broken spirit, a broken and a contrite heart—these, O God, You will not despise.

2 Samuel 22:47 – The Lord lives! Blessed *be* my Rock! Let God be exalted, the Rock of my salvation!

1 Kings 8:23 – ... and he said: “Lord God of Israel, *there is* no God in heaven above or on earth below like You, who keep *Your* covenant and mercy with Your servants who walk before You with all their hearts.

Psalms 86:11 – Teach me Your way, O Lord; I will walk in Your truth; unite my heart to fear Your name.

1 Kings 18:21b – How long will you falter between two opinions? If the Lord *is* God, follow Him; but if Baal, follow him.

2 Kings 8:19 – Yet the Lord would not destroy Judah, for the sake of his servant David, as He promised him to give a lamp to him *and* his sons forever.

2 Kings 17:38-39 – And the covenant that I have made with you, you shall not forget, nor shall you fear other gods. ³⁹ But the Lord your God you shall fear; and He will deliver you from the hand of all your enemies.

2 Chronicles 7:14 – ... if My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land.

Ezra 3:11a – And they sang responsively, praising and giving thanks to the Lord: “For *He is* good, for His mercy *endures* forever toward Israel.”

Proverbs 2:1-10 – My son, if you receive my words and treasure up my commandments with you, ²making your ear attentive to wisdom and inclining your heart to understanding; ³yes, if you call out for insight and raise your voice for understanding, ⁴if you seek it like silver and search for it as for hidden treasures, ⁵then you will understand the fear of the LORD and find the knowledge of God. ⁶For the LORD gives wisdom; from his mouth come knowledge and understanding; ⁷he

stores up sound wisdom for the upright; he is a shield to those who walk in integrity,⁸ guarding the paths of justice and watching over the way of his saints.⁹ Then you will understand righteousness and justice and equity, every good path;¹⁰ for wisdom will come into your heart, and knowledge will be pleasant to your soul....
