April 2

- FCQ. 3 Why did God make you and all things? For his own glory.
- SCQ. 10 *How did God create man?* God created man male and female, after his own image, in knowledge, righteousness, and holiness, with dominion over the creatures.

April 9

- FCQ. 4 How can you glorify God? By loving him and doing what he commands.
- FCQ. 5 Why are you to glorify God? Because he made me and takes care of me.
- SCQ. 11 What are God's works of providence? God's works of providence are, his most holy, wise, and powerful preserving and governing all his creatures, and all their actions.

April 23

- FCQ. 6 Are there more gods than one? There is only one true God.
- FCQ. 7 How many persons is this one true God? Three.
- FCQ. 8 Name these three persons. The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.
- SCQ. 12 What special act of providence did God exercise towards man in the estate wherein he was created? When God had created man, he entered into a covenant of life with him, upon condition of perfect obedience; forbidding him to eat of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, upon pain of death.

April 30

- FCQ. 9 What is God? God is a Spirit and has no body as we do.
- SCQ. 13 Did our first parents continue in the estate wherein they were created? Our first parents, being left to the freedom of their own will, fell from the estate wherein they were created, by sinning against God.

May 7

- FCQ. 10 Where is God? God is everywhere.
- SCQ. 14 What is sin? Sin is any want of conformity unto, or transgression of, the law of God.

May 14

- FCQ. 11 Can you see God? No I cannot see God, but he can always see me.
- SCQ. 15 What was the sin whereby our first parents fell from the estate wherein they were created? The sin whereby our first parents fell from the estate wherein they were created, was their eating the forbidden fruit.

May 21

- FCQ. 12 Does God know all things? Yes nothing can be hid from God.
- FCQ. 13 Can God do all things? Yes God can do all his holy will.
- SCQ. 16 Did all mankind fall in Adam's first transgression? The covenant being made with Adam, not only for himself, but for his posterity; all mankind, descending from him by ordinary generation, sinned in him, and fell with

him, in his first transgression.

May 28

- FCQ. 14 Where do you learn how to love and obey God? In the Bible alone.
- FCQ. 15 Who wrote the Bible? Chosen men who wrote by the inspiration of the Holy Spirit.
- SCQ. 17 *Into what estate did the fall bring mankind?* The fall brought mankind into an estate of sin and misery.
- SCQ. 18 Wherein consists the sinfulness of that estate whereinto man fell? The sinfulness of that estate whereinto man fell, consists in the guilt of Adam's first sin, the want of original righteousness, and the corruption of his whole nature, which is commonly called original sin; together with all actual transgressions which proceed from it.

June 4

- FCQ. 16 Who were our first parents? Adam and Eve.
- FCQ. 17 *How did God make our first parents?* God made Adam's body out of the ground, and Eve's body out of a rib from Adam.
- SCQ. 19 What is the misery of that estate whereinto man fell? All mankind by their fall lost communion with God, are under his wrath and curse, and so made liable to all the miseries of this life, to death itself, and to the pains of hell forever..

June 11

- FCQ. 18 What did God give Adam and Eve besides bodies? He gave them spirits that will last forever.
- FCQ. 19 Do you have a spirit as well as a body? Yes and my spirit is going to last forever.
- SCQ. 20 Did God leave all mankind to perish in the estate of sin and misery? God, having out of his mere good pleasure, from all eternity, elected some to everlasting life, did enter into a covenant of grace to deliver them out of the estate of sin and misery, and to bring them into an estate of salvation by a Redeemer.

June 18

- FCQ. 20 How do you know your spirit will last forever? Because the Bible tells me so.
- FCQ. 21 *In what condition did God make Adam and Eve?* He made them holy and happy.
- SCQ. 21 Who is the Redeemer of God's elect? The only Redeemer of God's elect is the Lord Jesus Christ, who, being the eternal Son of God, became man, and so was, and continues to be, God and man in two distinct natures, and one person, forever.
