September 30

- FC 126 What sign is used in baptism? Washing with water.
- FC 127 What does this washing with water represent? Union with Christ by cleansing through his blood.
- FC 128 In whose name are you baptized? In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.
- FC 129 Who are to be baptized? Believers and their children.
- FC 130 Why are we baptized even as little infants? Because God's command to Abraham is obeyed in our baptism.

- FC 136 Who may rightly partake of the Lord's Supper? Those who repent of their sins, believe in Christ and live a new life.

WSC 107 – What does the conclusion of the Lord's Prayer teach us? The conclusion of the Lord's Prayer, which is, For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen, teaches us to take our encouragement in prayer from God only, and in our prayers to praise him, ascribing kingdom, power, and glory to him; and, in testimony of our desire, and assurance to be heard, we say, Amen.

October 21

- FC 137 Did Christ remain in the tomb after he was buried? No he came back out of his tomb on the third day.
- WSC 1 What is the chief end of man? Man's chief end is to glorify God, and to enjoy him forever.

October 28 – Reformation Sunday

Galatians 3:19-25 – What purpose then *does* the law *serve?* It was added because of transgressions, till the Seed should come to whom the promise was made; *and it was* appointed through angels by the hand of a mediator. ²⁰ Now a mediator does not *mediate* for one *only*, but God is one. ²¹ Is the law then against the promises of God? Certainly not! For if there had been a law given which could have given life, truly righteousness would have been by the law. ²² But the Scripture has confined all under sin, that the promise by faith in Jesus Christ might be given to those who believe. ²³ But before faith came, we were kept under guard by the law, kept for the faith which would afterward be revealed. ²⁴ Therefore the law was our tutor *to bring us* to Christ, that we might be justified by faith. ²⁵ But after faith has come, we are no longer under a tutor.

November 4

- FC 138 Where is Jesus now? At the right hand of the Father, praying for us.
- FC 140 What will happen to us when we die? Our bodies will return to dust, while our spirits return to God.
- WSC 2 What rule has God given to direct us how we may glorify and enjoy him? The Word of God, which is contained in the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments, is the only rule to direct us how we may glorify and enjoy him.
- WSC 3 What do the Scriptures principally teach? The Scriptures principally teach, what man is to believe concerning God, and what duty God requires of man.

November 11

- FC 139 Will the Lord Jesus come again? Yes! He will return to judge the world on the last day.
- FC 141 Will the bodies of all the dead be raised again? Yes some will be raised to everlasting life and others to everlasting death.
- WSC 4 What is God? God is a Spirit, infinite, eternal, and unchangeable, in his being, wisdom, power, holiness, justice, goodness, and truth.

November 18 – Thanksgiving Sunday

Psalm 100 – A Psalm of Thanksgiving. Make a joyful shout to the Lord, all you lands! Serve the Lord with gladness; come before His presence with singing. Know that the Lord, He *is* God; *it is* He *who* has made us, and not we ourselves; *we are* His people and the sheep of His pasture. Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, *and* into His courts with praise. Be thankful to Him, *and* bless His name. For the Lord *is* good; His mercy *is* everlasting, and His truth *endures* to all generations.

November 25

- FC 142 What will God do to the unbelievers on the last day? He will cast them into the lake of fire, along with Satan and his angels.
- FC 143 What will the lake of fire be like? It will be an awful place, where the lost will suffer for their sins forever.
- WSC 4 What is God? God is a Spirit, infinite, eternal, and unchangeable, in his being, wisdom, power, holiness, justice, goodness, and truth.

December 2

- FC 144 What will God do for believers on the last day? He will give them a home in the new heaven and the new earth.
- FC 145 What will the new heaven and the new earth be like? It will be a glorious and happy place, where the saved will be with Jesus forever.
- WSC 5 Are there more Gods than one? There is but one only, the living and true God.
- WSC 6 *How many persons are there in the Godhead?* There are three persons in the Godhead: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost; and these three are one God, the same in substance, equal in power and glory.
